*Admonish one another (Rom. 15:14)*

- A healthy church family is a body of believers who are:  
Living in Harmony with One Another (Understanding)
  - ◊ Accepting of One Another
  - ◊ **Admonishing One Another**
- The Connection with Rom. 15:7 ...
  - Although the model for our acceptance of others is \_\_\_\_\_ (vv. 7-12) and the outworking of His abundant \_\_\_\_\_, Christ doesn't allow us to continue welcoming each other \_\_\_\_\_.

1 Cor. 5:4-7  
1 Cor. 11:19

*When do we make the "switch"?*

- Paul makes three observations of the Roman believers ...
  - **"Full of Goodness"**
    - The word "goodness" means "\_\_\_\_\_ moral qualities". (Greek-English Lexicon of the NT, pg. 741)
    - Often "goodness" must be clarified with a \_\_\_\_\_ that shows action and relationship, e.g. "you are full of doing good".
    - Being and doing good is a fruit of the \_\_\_\_\_, meaning that our goodness is \_\_\_\_\_ the work of God's \_\_\_\_\_.
  - **"Filled with All Knowledge"**
    - NIV uses the phrase "\_\_\_\_\_ in knowledge", while the NCV & CEV use the phrase "have all the knowledge you \_\_\_\_\_".

*"This does not mean learned in an academic sense but rather a sound, practical understanding of the Christian*

*faith that will issue in wholesome, helpful conduct."* (Boice, Romans, Vol. 4 pg. 1848)

- Paul's compliment of the Roman believers includes not only their \_\_\_\_\_ to do the right thing, but also their \_\_\_\_\_ of what the right thing is!
- **"Able also to Admonish"**
  - "Able" (δύναμενός) has the idea of being \_\_\_\_\_ (see vs. 13) and, in this context, being \_\_\_\_\_.
  - "Admonish" has several different translations but one primary meaning:
    - Acts 20:31 .... \_\_\_\_\_
    - Colossians 1:28 & 3:16 .... \_\_\_\_\_
    - 1 Thessalonians 5:12 .... \_\_\_\_\_
    - 1 Thessalonian 5:14 .... \_\_\_\_\_
    - 2 Thessalonians 3:15 .... \_\_\_\_\_

*How does admonishing provide "balance" to Paul's instruction to accept one another?*

- What does this mean to us and the CLBC family?
  - \_\_\_\_\_ are essential to the health of our church family.
  - Admonishment is the responsibility (obligation) of \_\_\_\_\_ member of the church family.
  - Admonishment must be \_\_\_\_\_ and flow from a deep \_\_\_\_\_ and love.
  - Admonishment must be \_\_\_\_\_ if it is to be credible.
  - Admonishment must have the proper \_\_\_\_\_ - *"... that we may present everyone mature in Christ ..."* (Col. 1:28)

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
