 - b. Consider a men's retreat or a father/son retreat
 - c. Strengthen the annual Deacon-Staff Planning Session to make it more leadership development oriented
 - d. Develop a job description for and hire a youth pastor
6. Work on other ministry initiatives
 - a. Initiate possible church Constitution revisions by developing an ad hoc committee on the Deacon Board to address issues
 - b. Initiate a discussion with the deacons about a five year plan for CLBC (2011-15)
 - c. Analyze and improve our Wednesday Bible study and prayer meeting
 - d. Build upon the work already done by the deacons and Pastor Dwayne and institute a missions committee
